Daily Schedule:	Parking area opens at 6:30 a.m. Registration and refreshments open at 7:00 a.m. Long Ride - approximately 4 hours, will start at 8:00 a.m. - Combination walk, trot, canter. A bit more challenging and not for the beginner. Lots of ravines and possible water crossings. A few rocky places, but rideable for the barefoot horse. Short Ride '#1' - about 1.5 hours will start at 9:00 a.m. Short Ride '#2' - about 1.5 hours will start at 10:00 a.m. - Nice walk, occasional trot. Short easy, confidence building trail. No huge inclines but some high brush, jeans or chaps recommended. Lunch will be served between 11:30 and 2:30. Rider awards will begin at 1:00 p.m

Other Info:	Current Negative Coggins for each horse entering the park is required for participation and must be presented at registration the morning of the ride. All rides will be guided by persons familiar with the park and terrain, we don't want anyone lost. Guest lunches are \$10.00. All guest lunches must be ordered and paid for by October 15. Rider lunches are provided at no additional cost. Coffee, water and a small breakfast will be served. The ride will be held rain or shine, so bring your rain gear just in case! Bring your own chairs, and remember this is a national park and we each need to 'pack out' whatever we 'pack in'. Riders must be 12 years of age or older. Riders 12 to 18 years old must be accompanied on the ride by a parent or guardian. Helmets are mandatory for all riders under the age of 18. Lots of prizes, raffles and awards! Some awards include the 'best dressed' horse and rider and the "Pinkest" horse. Awards for top 10 money raising riders will be determined by contributions received by midnight, October 28th.
